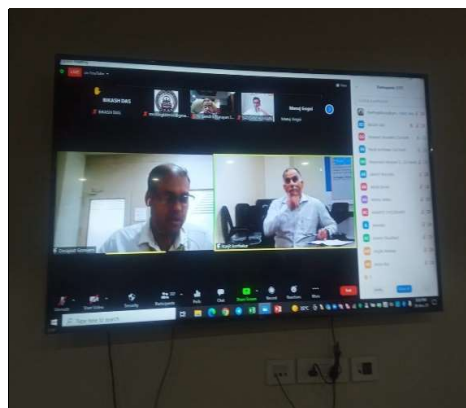
Targeted Participants: The target group of the webinar are the present learners of all the programmes as well as the alumni of the University.
