শিক্ষা জাতিৰ মেৰুদণ্ড স্বৰূপ। শিক্ষাই জ্ঞান আৰু জ্ঞানেই শক্তি। এটা শক্তিশালী জাতি বা এখন শক্তিশালী দেশ গঢ়িবৰ বাবে সমাজৰ সকলো লোকেই শিক্ষিত হ'ব লাগিব। সেয়েহে বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ৰ সকলো বিদ্যায়তনিক কাম-কাজৰ লগতে উচ্চশিক্ষা লাভৰ পৰা বঞ্চিতসকলৰ মাজতো দূৰ শিক্ষা ব্যৱস্থাৰ মাধ্যমেৰে শিক্ষা লাভৰ সুবিধা আগবঢ়াবলৈ কৃষ্ণকান্ত সন্দিকৈ ৰাজ্যিক মুক্ত বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়খন প্ৰতিষ্ঠা কৰা হৈছে। অসম চৰকাৰৰ দ্বাৰা প্ৰতিষ্ঠিত আৰু ভাৰত চৰকাৰৰ দ্বাৰা স্বীকৃতিপ্ৰাপ্ত এই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়খন ইন্দিৰা গান্ধী ৰাষ্ট্ৰীয় মুক্ত বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়কে ধৰি দেশৰ চতুৰ্দশ মুক্ত বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় আৰু উত্তৰ পূব ভাৰতৰ একমাত্ৰ ৰাজ্যিক মুক্ত বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়। এই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ৰ বাবে সুখবৰ যে, কানাডাৰ ভেংকৰাৰত অৱস্থিত আন্তঃচৰকাৰী সংস্থা 'কমনৱেলথ্ অব লাৰ্নিং'-এ প্ৰতি দুবছৰৰ মূৰে মূৰে প্ৰদান কৰা 'এক্সেলেন্স ফৰ ইনষ্টিটিউচনেল এচিভমেণ্ট' (Excellence for Institutional Achievement) বঁটা ২০১১-২০১৩ বৰ্ষৰ বাবে এই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ে লাভ কৰিছে। মূলতঃ শিক্ষাৰ গুণগত মান, পৰম্পৰাগত শিক্ষাই ঢুকি নোপোৱা বা সামৰি ল'ব নোৱাৰাসকলৰ মাজত শিক্ষাৰ প্ৰসাৰ আৰু প্ৰচাৰ, বিশেষভাৱে সক্ষম ব্যক্তি আৰু কাৰাগাৰবাসীসকলক বিনামূলীয়া শিক্ষা প্ৰদান কৰা বাবেই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ে এই আন্তঃৰাষ্ট্ৰীয় বঁটা লাভ কৰে। উল্লেখযোগ্য যে, দেশৰ প্ৰাকৃতিক সম্পদৰ ভিত্তিত মানৱ সম্পদৰ উন্নয়ন আৰু নিয়োগ সৃষ্টিৰ জৰিয়তে দেশৰ অৰ্থনীতিক গঢ় দিবলৈ শৈক্ষিক দিশৰ পৰা চেষ্টা চলোৱাটো এই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ৰ অন্যতম প্ৰধান উদ্দেশ্য।

এই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ে আনুষ্ঠানিক শিক্ষাৰ উচ্চতৰ মাধ্যমিক (১০+২ স্তৰ) পৰীক্ষাত ইতিমধ্যে উত্তীৰ্ণ হ'ব নোৱাৰা বা অৱতীৰ্ণ নোহোৱাসকলেও যাতে উচ্চশিক্ষাৰ সপোন বাস্তৱায়িত কৰিব পাৰে, সেই কথা সাৰোগত কৰি 'স্নাতক প্ৰস্তুতি পাঠ্যক্ৰম' নামৰ এটি পাঠ্যক্ৰম আগবঢ়াইছে। এই পাঠ্যক্ৰম ২০১০ চনৰ জানুৱাৰী পৰ্যন্ত ছমহীয়া আছিল যদিও পাঠ্যক্ৰমৰ মানদণ্ড বৃদ্ধি কৰাৰ উদ্দেশ্যে ২০১০ চনৰ জুলাই মাহৰ পৰা ইয়াৰ ম্যাদ এবছৰীয়া কৰা হৈছিল আৰু এই বছৰৰ পৰা, বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় অনুদান আয়োগৰ নিৰ্দেশাৱলীৰ পৰিপ্ৰেক্ষিতত ইয়াৰ সময়সীমা দুবছৰীয়া কৰা হৈছে; যাতে 'স্নাতক প্ৰস্তুতি পাঠ্যক্ৰম'ত উত্তীৰ্ণ হৈ এজন শিক্ষাৰ্থীয়ে স্নাতক মহলাৰ পাঠ্যক্ৰমৰ ধাৰাৰ লগত বিশেষ অসুবিধা নোহোৱাকৈ সহজতে নিজকে খাপ খুৱাব পাৰে আৰু নিযুক্তি আৰু কৰ্মক্ষেত্ৰৰ প্ৰাপ্য আদায়ৰ ক্ষেত্ৰতো কোনো অসুবিধাৰ সন্মুখীন নহয়। আমি আশা কৰিছোঁ, উচ্চশিক্ষা লাভৰ প্ৰতি আগ্ৰহী অথচ বিভিন্ন কাৰণত শিক্ষা লাভ কৰিব নোৱাৰা ব্যক্তিসকল এই পাঠ্যক্ৰমৰ জৰিয়তে উপকৃত হ'ব আৰু সমাজৰ এগৰাকী শিক্ষিত ব্যক্তি হিচাপে সপোন দিঠকত ৰূপায়িত কৰিব পাৰিব। স্নাতক প্ৰস্তুতি পাঠ্যক্ৰমত উত্তীৰ্ণ হৈ এই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ৰ যিকোনো স্নাতক বা ডিপ্ল'মা পাঠ্যক্ৰম সম্পূৰ্ণ কৰাসকলে ভাৰতবৰ্ষৰ যিকোনো বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ৰ মানপত্ৰধাৰীৰ সমতুল্য হ'ব আৰু অসম চৰকাৰে বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়লৈ আনুষ্ঠানিক পত্ৰ যোগে জনাইছে যে এই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ৰ পৰা ডিগ্ৰী, ডিপ্ল'মা আৰু মানপত্ৰ লাভ কৰাসকলে চৰকাৰী চাকৰি তথা উচ্চ শিক্ষাৰ বাবে অৰ্হতাপ্ৰাপ্ত হ'ব।

Dear Vice-Chancellor,

As you are aware, the Open Universities have been established in the country by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature in accordance with the provisions contained in Section 2(f) of University Grants Commission Act, 1956. These universities are therefore, empowered to award degrees in terms of Section 22(1) of the UGC Act, 1956.

It has been brought to the notice of the Commission that the students who have done their M.A. from open universities are debarred by universities from registration for Ph.D. studies. This is most unfair in view of the importance attached to the Open University and distance learning in National Policy on Education, 1986. The programme of Action - 02 also aims at promoting the mobility of student among open universities and among traditional universities. This can be made possible only when there is a workable understanding between open universities for recognition of each other's degrees on reciprocal basis. A Memorandum of Understanding has already been signed between Universities of Pondicherry and Indira Gandhi National Open University which provides for recognition of each other's degrees and diplomas as well as transfer of credits for courses successfully completed by students between the two universities. The other universities may also make similar arrangements so that the mobility of students from Open University stream to traditional universities is ensured without any difficulty.

I hope that your university will make necessary efforts in this direction and let the Commission know the progress.

The Standing Committee at its 237th meeting held at Utkal University and the 68th Annual Session of the AIU in December, 1993 at the University of Delhi have decided in principle that the Degrees of the Open Universities be recognized in terms of the following resolutions:

“Resolved that the examinations of one University should be recognized by another on reciprocal basis, provided that the entrance qualification, duration of course and the general standard of attainment are similar to those prescribed by the recognized university.”

“Further resolved that in case of Degrees awarded by Open Universities, the conditions regarding entrance qualifications and duration of the course be relaxed provided that the general standard of attainment are similar to those prescribed by the recognized university.”

The decision is brought to the notice of the Universities for favour of appropriate action in the matter. The additional information, if required in this behalf, may kindly be obtained from the Registrar of the Universities direct.

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

(In brief)

Krishna Kanta Handiqui State Open University was established under the provision of the Krishna Kanta Handique State Open University, Act, 2005 enacted by the Assam Legislative Assembly and published in the Assam Gazette (extraordinary) dt 29/9/05 by the Govt. of Assam. It started functioning with the joining of Professor Srinath Baruah as its first Vice-Chancellor on 11th December, 2006.

The University has been vested with the authority to prepare its own curricula, create own system of examination and to admit, examine and confer degrees, diplomas and certificates to the learners registered with it up to degree and post-degree level courses.

The University has been recognised and its academic programmes approved by the Distance Education Council (DEC), New Delhi. Vide letter No. DEC/Misei/07/5957 dated October 3, 2007 and by the University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi vide letter No. F.9-13/2008(CPP-I) dated March 18, 2009. In addition to that, the Govt. of Assam has recognised all Degrees, Diplomas and Certificates awarded by this University for job and higher education vide Lettter No. AHE/228/2007/330 dated May 08, 2009.

The headquarters of the University is located at Patgaon, Rani, Guwahati - 781017 and its City Office is at Last Gate, Dispur, Guwahati - 781006.

Motto :

The very purpose of establishment of the University is to promote education to reach the unreached through the Open and Distance Learning System and the motto of the University is '**Education Beyond Barriers**' of age, academic background and geographical boundaries.

Objectives :

The main objectives of the Krishna Kanta Handiqui State Open University are:

1. to provide access to higher education to large segments of the population, and in particular the disadvantaged groups, such as those living in remote and rural areas including working people, housewives and other adults who wish to upgrade or acquire

- knowledge through studies in various fields;
2. to provide opportunities for higher education to a larger segment of the population, including those who could not pursue higher education in the appropriate time due to one reason or the other;
 3. to strengthen and diversify the degree, diploma and certificate courses for capacity building related to the needs of employment and necessary for building the economy of the country on the basis of its natural and human resources;
 4. to contribute to the improvement of the educational system in the State by providing a non-formal channel complementary to the formal system;
 5. to advance and disseminate learning and knowledge by a diversity of means including the use of Information and Communication Technology (ICT);
 6. to provide education and training to people with a view to develop skills in various vocational trades, arts and craft;
 7. to provide counselling and guidance to the learners.

Vision & Mission :

The aim of the University is to develop and provide easily accessible modes of quality higher education and training with the use of latest educational inputs and technologies. Because of the inherent flexibility in terms of pace and place of learning, methods of evaluation etc., KKHSOU holds the promise of providing equality of opportunities for higher education and bringing into its fold the deprived and denied sections of people of this region. In order to reach those disadvantaged groups due to educational, economic and geographical problem or any other adverse circumstances, KKHSOU has special programmes with special system of delivery. The University has been formulating academic programmes to suit the less educated, educated and higher educated groups to achieve the goal of providing higher education and training at the doorstep of the seekers of higher education.

With a view to making higher education more accessible, KKHSOU has classified its diverse academic programmes to suit the needs of the potential learners of the following target groups :

1. People living in rural, remote, mountainous and border areas.
2. Persons deprived of higher education at a young age and desirous to improve their qualification.
3. People engaged in different services, business, agriculture or other professions.
4. Persons deprived of admission in conventional Universities of the State,
5. Women, particularly housewives.
6. People belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, socially and educationally backward classes.
7. Differently abled persons.

Training Programmes:

In addition to the above mentioned programmes, the University has been organising vocational training programmes for a number of trades at different places (ITIs and Polytechnics) of the state to encourage entrepreneurship and enhance employability of the youths. It has been decided to organise such programmes in the coming years also.

Eligibility for Bachelor Degree and Diploma Programmes:

The students who have passed 10+2 stage or Bachelor Preparatory Programme (BPP) will be eligible to register themselves in the above mentioned Bachelor's degree programmes and diploma programmes. The eligibility criteria for the Ph. D., M. Phil., Master's, PG Diploma and other programmes are enumerated in the relevant prospectus.

Bachelor Preparatory Programme (BPP):

In the traditional universities, only 10 + 2 pass students are qualified to take admission into the degree courses. As a mandate of open universities, K.K. Handiqui State Open University gives opportunity to those who have not passed 10+2 and have attained 19 years of age on 1st April of the year of admission but are desirous of undergoing higher studies. For such persons, the University offers this Bachelor Preparatory Programme (BPP) of two-year duration to qualify themselves and to make them eligible to take admission into the degree programmes.

Those learners who could not pursue education for various reasons but have the potential and zeal to fulfil their hidden desire of acquiring higher education can take advantage of this programme.

Bachelor Preparatory Programme is of two-year duration, which starts from April and examinations are held in the month of March next year. There will be 6 papers of 100 marks (4 credits) each year. Each paper will have assignments of 20% weightage.

Those who cannot clear any paper in one attempt will be given the opportunity to clear the examinations in four attempts (within six years). However, such learners shall be required to pay the examination fees each time they appear in examination. Learners failing to pass the BPP in four attempts (within six years), shall be allowed re-admission in BPP on payment of full course fees.

BPP programme is offered in three streams as detailed below :

Note :

- 1) *Educational qualification for admission into BCA is generally 10+2 pass in science. But those who have passed Higher Secondary (10+2) in Arts, Commerce and Science without having either Computer Science or Mathematics and yet desire to enrol in Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA) shall have to clear Stream 3 (BPP for BCA) of first year of the programme for their eligibility. It should be noted that candidates having Higher Secondary (10+2) qualifications with either Mathematics or Computer Science as one of the papers and have passed the same are eligible to take admission into the BCA programme. Candidates not having passed either Mathematics or Computer Science at 10+2 stage shall have to clear first year courses of Stream 3 (BPP for BCA).*
- 2) *Again, those who have already passed Higher Secondary (10+2) in Arts and desire to enrol in B.Com or BBA will have to clear Stream 2 (BPP for B.Com/BBA) of first year of the programme for their eligibility.*
- 3) *Learners who passed Higher Secondary, but did not have the requisite courses at the Higher Secondary level as required above and have taken admission into the first semester of BCA or BBA programmes, shall have to take admission in the relevant BPP (Stream 2 or Stream 3 as may be applicable) during the first semester of the Degree programme itself. Only on successful completion of the Papers of Stream 2 or Stream 3 of BPP will they be eligible for award of certificates, diploma and degree.*

Eligibility for admission to BPP :

Those completing 19 years of age on the first day of April of the year in which admission is applied for will be eligible for enrolment. To be specific, for the session 2014-15 one has to complete 19 years of age as on the 1st of April 2014.

- No other fee will be paid to any one which is not included in the fee structure.
- The learners are to pay the total fee for a year in the form of Bank Journal or Draft drawn in favour of "K.K. Handiqui State Open University" payable at Guwahati.
- Course fee will include supply of Self Learning Material, counselling sessions, postal charges and other unspecified costs

The University provides free education to differently abled learners, prisoners and jail inmates.

Admission Procedure :

- * Application alongwith the total fee in the form of Bank Journal or Bank Draft drawn in favour of "Krishna Kanta Handiqui State Open University" payable at Guwahati and relevant enclosures (proof of age and qualification) are required to be submitted at the recognized Study Centre well within the due date.
- * The Study Centre will scrutinize the application forms as per the norms and qualifications required for the programme.
- * After scrutiny the eligible applicants will be provisionally admitted by the Study Centre. Either the In-charge or the Co-ordinator of the study centre will sign such application form for onward transmission to the university.
- * Their enrolment will be confirmed on fulfillment of eligibility requirements. To appear in

the examinations, confirmation of enrolment will be necessary.

- * All the enrolled learners will be provided with the enrolment number, programme guidelines and identity cards.
- * Those learners who are unable to complete the programme within the specified validity period will be required to register themselves afresh by paying the requisite fee as per the University regulations.

Continuous Admission :

- * After completion of the first year, admission into the second year is required within one month of the last examination of the first year. It does not depend on whether appeared in examination, or the result of the first year. Admission will have to be taken continuously in the programme without any break. A learner will be allowed to appear in all the examinations including back within the stipulated time of the BPP programme, i.e., six years.
- * A learner will have to take admission to the second year within one month from the last date of examination of the first year.
- * A learner will be allowed to take admission to the next semester beyond one month but within two months from the last date of examination of the previous semester with a fine of ₹500.
- * Under special circumstances and on special consideration, a learner may be allowed admission in the second year even beyond two months but before issue of notification for filling up of forms for examination of that year by the University on individual application with sufficient reasons and on payment of a fine of ₹1000.

Refusal/Cancellation of Admission :

Notwithstanding, anything contained in the prospectus, the University reserves the right to refuse/cancel admission of any individual

Self Learning materials :

Self Learning materials are specially designed by teams of experts drawn from

relevant academic areas and scrutinized by experts to meet the learners' demand. These will be provided to the Learners through the Study Centres. The Learners will have to give their option on the medium of study materials - English or Assamese.

Support Services :

Study Centres provide learners with a platform to interact with counsellors, other learners and also to use library. Learners will receive personal attention and support at the Study Centres. The Study Centres will provide counselling and hands on experience (as may be necessary). These centres will act as the access and contact points between the learners and the University.

Counselling Sessions :

There will be counselling sessions arranged in the Study Centres for BPP Courses. All sessions will be held on Sundays only. There will be at least 30 counselling sessions for every stream to be arranged and notified by the respective study centres.

Examination :

The examination will be conducted as per the university guidelines and the examination centres will be allotted by the university only. The learners have to be ready to take their examination in their respective exam. centre. Question papers will be printed only in English and Assamese. However, intending learners of BPP will have the option of writing their answers in any of the media, namely English, Assamese, Bengali, Hindi, Bodo.
