1. Agenda item No. 1: Introductory remarks by Vice-Chancellor

While extending a warm welcome to all the members of the Board, particularly Dean (Academic) and Dean (Study Centre) who attended the meeting of the Board for the first time, Vice-Chancellor in his introductory remarks apprised the Hon'ble members of the Board of the following

- Although the State government allotted Rs. 1.67 crores under non-plan primarily for payment of salary during the financial year 2012-13, the Director Higher Education, who is the DDO for the University, did not draw the amount in spite of submission of the statement of expenditures and utilization certificate by the University utilization of the thrice, and thereby deprived the University of the budgeted non-plan grant. Registrar has, during 2013-14 by taking into account both the shortfall for the current year as well as the non-plan amount that could not be drawn during 2012-13.
- As per the decision of the last meeting of the Borad, His Excellency the Governor of Assam was approached to request the Hon'ble President of India to be the Chief Guest of Iook for other person(s) informing that the President was unlikely to accept the invitation. When Hon'ble Chief Minister was informed about this in a meeting with him on 16th July, persons as the Chief Guest.

- The Chief Minister of Assam convened a joint meeting of the members of the Board of Management and the high officials of Finance, Planning & Development and Education Departments to sort out the problems relating to approval of posts and financial support for permanent campus of the university. The meeting decided to release Rs. 50 crores against the proposal of infrastructural development at permanent campus and also to approve the proposal of 65 teaching and non-teaching posts.
