The meeting was held under the chairmanship of Prof. Srinath Baruah, Vice-Chancellor.

The Chairman at the outset extended hearty welcome to the members and apprised that the University had already issued admission notification for BP Programme and admissions are going on through more than 70 Study Centres across the state and preparation for other programmes are also on. Unfortunately the Academic Council of the University could not be constituted in absence of the key positions being created by the Government to fill up. Therefore, for the greater interest of the University, the Vice-Chancellor in exercise of powers Under Section 37(5) of the Act constituted this Academic Committee for smooth sailing of the academic programmes. He then sought co-operation and expert advice from the members particularly from the experts coming from Gauhati University so that the University can take the right steps in formulating and implementing its academic programmes. Discussions on agenda items followed.

### $\underline{AGENDA 1}$ : Consideration and approval of Regulations on Admission.

### Resolution 01.01.2008

The members had gone through the draft Regulations circulated and after detail deliberations approved the same with minor amendments  $\epsilon$  s given at **Annexure I** and recommended the same for approval of Board of Management (Management Committee).

# $\underline{\textit{AGENDA 2}}$ : Fixation of eligibility qualification for bachelor's programmes and other Diploma/Certificate Courses

The OSD (Acad.) apprised the members that queries have been received including e-mails particularly from Polytechnique diplema holders and some who



Jeared BPP of IGNOU, whether, such candidates are to clear BPP of this University to pursue higher studies. The members discussed the matter including qualifications · required for undergoing certificate courses and decided as follows:

### Resolution 01.02.2008

- Candidates who cleared BPP from any Open University of the country approved by the Distance Education Council will be eligible for admission in Bachelor's Programmes.
- Technical/Professional Diploma holders from the State Polytechniques after matriculation will be eligible to get admission in Bachelor's ii)
- For undergoing Diploma/Certificate courses candidates should normally have 10+2 or BPP pass qualification. Exceptions will however, be notified. iii)

### Consideration of applications from Private Sector AGENDA 3: Institutions seeking Study Centres of the University:

The members considered the applications received from various Private Institutions/Junior Colleges etc. and recommended as follows for approval of Board of Management (Management Committee).

### Resolution 03.01.2008:

- Institutions run by Family Trust should not be allowed to become Study i) Centre.
- Junior Colleges without having affiliation from Higher Secondary Council ii) should not be permitted to become Study Centres.
